Minutes

The City of Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau January 15, 2019

The Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau met on Tuesday, January 15, 2019. The meeting was called to order in the training room of the Nitro Police Station. Those in attendance were Bill Racer, Bill Fortune, Bill Javins, Ivan Meadows, John Young, Julia Washington, Carmen Kostelansky, Susan Valleau and Mayor David Casebolt. Also, in attendance was CVB Executive Director Joe Stevens.

A quorum was determined to be present and the minutes were reviewed and a motion to accept the minutes was made by Ivan Meadows and seconded by Susan Valleau. The motion was adopted.

A financial report was presented and a motion to accept the report was made by Bill Javins and seconded by Susan Valleau. The motion was adopted. John Young also reported to the board that he has been in discussion with Mardi Gras' financial supervisor and was working on a new procedure for the Hotel/Motel Tax to be collected. Mr. Young reported there was still \$16,000 outstanding but expects the payment in any day.

Joe Stevens updated the board on the success of the Mistletoe Market and Christmas Parade. Director Valleau added she felt the parade was the biggest ever and would like to see some type of judging for participants for the next parade. The board was informed of an upcoming meeting with the Casino's new GM with Mayor Casebolt, Stevens and Kim Reed of the Nitro Development Authority. The board was informed that work had begun on the city's website. Stevens reported of his attendance at the 2019 State Fairs and Festivals Convention in Charleston and he learned of a new way to do surveys of the city's events. The board was also informed of the CVB and City's involvement with the Heads Up Community Alert system.

There was also discussion centering around the upcoming Easter Extravaganza and Stevens reported on some changes in this year's event.

In new business, Director Meadows informed the board that the WV District Little League Road Show was again taking place in Nitro and asked for welcome packets from the CVB.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 pm with the next meeting to take place, Tuesday, February 5, 2019.
