Based on our discussions prior to the past legislative session, TSG Consulting, LLC, submits this proposal for your consideration. The Economic Developmental Authority desires to look at its role moving forward and increase its ability to generate long-term economic growth.

TSG Consulting will work with the CVB to determine the authority's vision for the agency. We will review past activities of the authority to determine what has worked and what has not worked. Part of our review will be to determine if the past activities of the CVB are applicable to those of a successful CVB. Next, we will review similar CVBs around the state that have been successful to learn best practices.

Once the research is completed, we will develop short- and long-term plans for the CVB. Included will be the establishment of goals. These plans will look at staffing and budget and outreach. We will work with the authority to establish a business plan for the CVB. Part of the process will be to prioritize the future actions of the CVB. These would be operational plans.

The city and the area around the city have great potential for tourism. The city, however, needs to capitalize on its assets. The CVB competes with other areas of the state and region and cannot continue on the same path and create opportunities to attract more visitors and economic activity.

This process will take 90 days, and the following deliverables will be provided under an engagement:

- Review of past activities
- Review of budget
- · Review of staffing
- Review of other similar CVBs
- Work with the CVB board to develop a vision for the operation of the agency
- Development of a business plan that ensures sustainability

- Development of long- and short-term plans for the CVB, including staffing
- Development of a vison, as well as a mission statement, for the agency

These items will be included in a final report that will be submitted to the CVB.

The cost of this engagement will be \$3,750 in addition to the current retainer for the branding project. The CVB will be billed for out-of-pocket expenses at cost, including printing and travel.
