Minutes

The City of Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau

May 4, 2021

The Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau met on Tuesday, May 4, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Bill Javins and held in City Council chambers with social distancing in place. Those attending the meeting in person were Bill Javins, Bill Fortune, Ivan Meadows, Susan Valleau, Jason Redman, Brian Knost (Althaus) and John Young. Also, in attendance was CVB Executive Director Joe Stevens and Tim Arnott, owner of Third Floor Comics.

A quorum was determined, and the minutes were reviewed and a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting was made by John Young and seconded by Jason Redman. The motion was adopted.

A financial report was presented by Treasurer John Young and a motion to accept the report was made by Jason Redman and seconded by Susan Valleau. The motion was adopted.

Young also reported that the Mardi Gras Casino was going to start submitting their Hotel/Motel Tax on a monthly basis, instead of quarterly.

Young also proposed increasing the director's wage by three percent. On a motion by Young and a second by Ivan Meadows the motion was adopted.

Stevens call on Mardi Gras' representative Brian Knost to provide an update on the casino and he reported that operations were getting back to normal. The biggest challenge right now is finding enough employees.

Joe Stevens presented the board his Director's report. The Visit Nitro Website has been updated and is current, upcoming events. Stevens called on Tim Arnott of Third Floor Comics to discuss his upcoming Mini-Con. On a motion by Susan Valleau and seconded by Jason Redman, Stevens was authorized to spend \$1268 with WKLC to promote the event. Stevens distributed proofs to the board the CVB's racks cards for the city and museum which are being redone for the state's welcome centers. Bill Fortune gave the board a progress report of the new Food Pantry. Stevens informed the board that the Flag of Honor motorcycle group was coming into Nitro May 26 and 27. Also, the city's chili cookoff was being combined with Charleston's and will be held on November 13.

In New Business, Stevens told the board the Get It To Go signs are hanging at the Nitro High Girls Softball Stadium. The banners feature a QR code enabling visitors to see the participants videos. Stevens went over the 2021 event calendar. Susan Valleau updated the board on the museum's renovations, with a July 4 reopening planned. Stevens reported three more restaurants have been added to the Get It To Go In Nitro Campaign, Diehl's Rebar and Rio Grande.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:28 pm on a motion by John Young and seconded Jason Redman. The next meeting to take place, Tuesday, June 8, 2021.
