The City of Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau

February 1, 2022

The Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau met on Tuesday, February 1, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Bill Javins and held in City Council chambers. Those attending the meeting in person were Susan Valleau, Bill Fortune, Carmen Kostelansky, Dave Casebolt Ivan Meadows, Tracey Toler and Julia Washington. Attending by phone was Jason Redman. Also, in attendance was CVB Executive Director Joe Stevens and Nitro City Council Woman Cynthia McGill.

A quorum was determined, and the minutes were reviewed and a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Bill Fortune and seconded by Julia Washington. The motion was adopted.

A financial report was presented by Executive Director Joe Stevens as Treasurer John Young was absent and a motion to accept the report was made by Susan Valleau and seconded by Ivan Meadows. The motion was adopted.

Joe Stevens presented the board his director's report. Stevens reported on upcoming and recent events. Stevens reported on the Tourism Day he attended at the State Capitol and that he met with the city's representatives.
