The City of Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau

April 6, 2021

The Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau met on Tuesday, April 6, 2021. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Javins and held at the CVB office, with social distancing in place. Those attending the meeting in person were Bill Javins, Bill Fortune, Ivan Meadows, Mayor Dave Casebolt, Julia Washington, Tracy Toler, Susan Valleau, Jason Redman and John Young. Attending the meeting by phone was Carmen Kostelansky. Also, in attendance was CVB Executive Director Joe Stevens.

A quorum was determined, and the minutes were reviewed and a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Susan Valleau and seconded by John Young. The motion was adopted.

A financial report was presented by Treasurer John Young and a motion to accept the report was made by Julia Washington and seconded by Susan Valleau. The motion was adopted.

Stevens reported that he received a message from CVB Board member and Mardi Gras President Eric Althaus that indicated that business climbed in March and the casino has opened one of its restaurants and will be reopening the hotel for seven days a week soon.

Joe Stevens presented the board his Director's report. The Visit Nitro Website has been updated and is current, upcoming events. Stevens called on Board member Bill Fortune to give an update on the new Nitro Food Pantry opening. Stevens explained to the board the CVB's racks cards were being redone for the state's welcome centers. Stevens requested all front door keys to be turned in as a new code lock had been installed. Also there was discussion on stocking of Ridenour Lake.

In New Business, Stevens had perspective new board member Jason Redman introduce himself, a motion was made by John Young and seconded by Julia Washington to accept Redman as a board member and the motioned passed. Stevens showed the board the Get It To Go sign that will be hung at the Nitro High Girls Softball Stadium. Young received permission from the board to open a new checking account to handle a new revenue stream created by Traveling softball and baseball tournaments. Stevens went over the 2021 event calendar, noting that the dates were just place marks and things could and may still change. There was also discussion on Nitro Business Videos and the CVB working with the NDA's Small Business Committee on the project. Carmen Kostelansky updated the board on the museum's renovations.
