July 5, 2022

The Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau met on Tuesday, July 5, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Bill Javins and held in Nitro City Council Chambers. Those attending the meeting in person were Jason Redman, Ivan Meadows, Mayor Dave Casebolt, Susan Valleau, Carmen Kostelansky (by phone), Bill Fortune, John Young and Tracy Toler. Also, in attendance was CVB Executive Director Joe Stevens.

A quorum was determined, and the minutes were reviewed and a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Bill Fortune and seconded by John Young. The motion was adopted.

A financial report was presented by Treasurer John Young and a motion to accept the report was made by Dave Casebolt and seconded by Susan Valleau. The motion was adopted.

Joe Stevens presented the board his director's report. Stevens reported on upcoming and recent events. Stevens told the board that an updated 2022 Calendar of Events was in their information kit.
