The City of Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau

December 6, 2022

The Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau met on Tuesday, December 6, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Bill Javins and held in Nitro City Council Chambers. Those attending the meeting in person were Ivan Meadows, Carmen Kostelansky, Tracy Toler, John Young, Jason Redman, Bill Fortune and Dave Casebolt. Also, in attendance was CVB Executive Director Joe Stevens and Tim Arnott, owner of Nitro Antique Mall and member of 21 & Bank Business Association.

A quorum was determined, and the minutes were reviewed and a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Ivan Meadows and seconded by Carmen Kotelansky. The motion was adopted.

A financial report was presented by John Young and a motion to accept the report was made by Carmen Kotelansky and seconded by Ivan meadows. The motion was adopted. It was mentioned at this time by Joe Stevens, that this was Young's final meeting as treasurer, due to retirement. Young suggested that Stevens provide the monthly financial reports to the board and the new CPA give an in depth reports quarterly.
